DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

ENAMEL PREPARATION Prophy the enamel surfaces with 1st & Final[®] pumice. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Etch the enamel surface for 30 seconds. Rinse and dry thoroughly. If using a self etching scrub the SEP into the enamel for 5 seconds, air dry thoroughly.

APPLICATION OF BONDING RESIN: Apply one coat of Assure[®] Universal Bonding Resin to each prepared tooth and stroke over to ensure penetration. Lightly air dry. Assure can be light cured to eliminate bracket drift, but not necessary. Proceed with the application of any chemical or light cure paste with bracket.

BONDING TO COMPOSITE, GOLD, AMALGAM, STAINLESS STEEL & PLASTIC: Prophy, rinse and dry. Sandblast, rinse and dry. Apply one coat of Assure[®] Universal Bonding Resin and lightly dry. Proceed with the application of paste and bracket.

BONDING TO PORCELAIN: Prophy, rinse and dry. Sandblast, rinse and dry. Apply Porcelain Etch, wait 4 minutes. Rinse and dry. Apply one coat of Porcelain Conditioner, wait 2 minutes. Dry for 30 seconds. Apply one coat of Assure, air dry and light cure for 10 seconds. Proceed with bracket placement.
